Exhibition Overview

- This exhibition celebrates the Art League of Long Island's master portrait teacher Suzanne Young, her continuous thread of influence and the genesis of a new generation of artists and teachers.
- The Art League invites entries of portraits and figures only. The exhibition will include invited works by Harvey Dinnerstein, David Levine, Daniel Schwartz and Burton Silverman. Aaron Shikler is the juror for awards.

Eligibility

- Open to artists residing in New Jersey, Connecticut, and New York, including Long Island, whether or not a present or former student of Suzanne Young.
- Artists may enter up to two works, only ONE of which may be accepted.
- Two- and three-dimensional work may be submitted in any medium except photography.
- Work must be original. No giclees or reproductions. We reserve the right to reject on delivery work of questionable facture.
- Accepted artists must gallery sit during this exhibit, to be scheduled at time of painting delivery, or pay an additional \$10 fee.

Specifications

- Two-D work may not exceed 42" in height and 38" in width, INCLUDING FRAME, and 35 lbs in weight.
- Three-D work may not exceed 15" wide by 15" deep by 30" high and 40 lbs in weight.
- Two-D work must be wired tightly. Stretched canvas, if unframed, must have staple-free edges. White or off-white matting only, and no sawtooth hangers. ALLI will not accept work that is damaged or does not meet the specified conditions.

Submission of Work

- Both slides and CDs will be accepted. Slides must be labeled with artist's name, title, size and medium, with a red dot on top right corner.
- Digital images must be in jpeg form, 300 dpi, 1800 pixels x 1200 pixels, on one CD. File names must be labeled as follows: "LastName_FirstInitial_Number_Title.jpeg" **Example: Smith_D_2_Babydoll.jpeg** (Number refers to entry 1 or 2.) Label CD case with artist's name in black marker. CDs will not be returned.

Deadline for receipt of application is August 10. Mail application form, slide(s) or CD, SASE and non-refundable entry fee of \$30 for one work, \$40 for two to:

Accepted Work

Accepted art work must be delivered unwrapped to the Art League on Tues., Sept. 22, from 3 - 8 pm. Out-of-town entries: SAFE ART TRANSPORT. INC., 1306 38th Ave., Long Island City, NY 11101, 718-392-8910 must have work by Wed., Sept. 16. Their fee is \$100. You may also use your own shipping agent if that agent will deliver the art unpacked and pick up on the designated dates.

No Fed Ex or UPS deliveries accepted. ALLI has neither the staff nor space to handle packing materials and repack.

Prizes & Sales

- Cash awards plus Honorable Mention gift certificates from Pearl Paint will be given at the discretion of the judge.
- The Art League will take a 25% commission on all sales.

Liability

- Entries will be handled with professional care. However the Art League will not be held liable for loss or damage to work.
- We reserve the right to photograph work for publicity purposes.
- Submission of work to this exhibit constitutes an agreement by the artist to the listed terms and conditions.
